DAY 1: Arrive in New York

No meals

Meet the tour guide at the baggage claim area. Transfer to hotel.

**Arrival must be between 8.30 am – 11.00 pm daily, or additional charge will be incurred.*

DAY 2: West Point Academy - Woodbury Premium Outlets

No meals

Guest will visit the United States Military Academy at West Point (**optional**), also known as West Point or The Academy, which is one of the oldest military academies. It is also the oldest continuously occupied military post in America which can date back to the Revolutionary War. We will arrange the tour led by the Academy's official tour guide. (All foreign national visitors must provide and present a valid passport and visa. All U.S. citizens age 16 and older must provide and present their own valid photo identification. Anyone under 16 must be accompanied by an adult). Next, shopping at the world's finest outlet, Woodbury Common Premium Outlets. Return to the hotel and overnight.

**Those who do not want to visit West Point will have the whole day for shopping at Woodbury Outlets*

DAY 3: New York City Tour

No meals

Stepping on top of the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, on levels 100, 101, and 102 of the 1,776foot tall One World Trade Center building, One World Observatory™ provides unique, panoramic views of New York City, its most iconic sites, and surrounding waters (**optional**). Take a sightseeing cruise tour on the Hudson River (**optional**) to enjoy the city view on a different angle as well as take pictures with the backdrops of Statue of Liberty and Brooklyn Bridge. Visit USS Intrepid (**optional**), Wall Street, Trinity Church, New York Stock Exchange and its signature sculpture Charging Bull, Times Square, and Metropolitan Museum of Arts (**optional**). The bus will pass-by Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center, and Ground Zero.

DAY 4: Philadelphia – Washington DC

No meals

In the morning, we will visit Philadelphia, well-known as the birthplace of American democracy. At the Independence National Historical Park, you will have a special moment of standing exactly where the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution were signed inside the Independence Hall. You also won't miss the Liberty Bell which is recognized for its famous crack. Go beyond the iconic crack to learn how this State House bell was transformed into an extraordinary symbol. You will also see the Statue of Washington, Congress Hall, and many other great attractions. Take the Philadelphia Double Decker Tour (**optional**). The London-style double-decker buses add the perfect touch to your journey. Aboard a genuine open-top double-decker bus giving you unobstructed views and an amazing experience. Pass by Philadelphia City Hall, Philadelphia History Museum, and other iconic sites, seeing Philadelphia from above!

Afterwards, head to Washington D.C. Visit U.S. Capitol (**optional in-depth tour**), White House (outside visit, 20 mins). Stop at the Lincoln Memorial. This grand monument overlooks the Reflecting Pool, the Washington Monument and the U.S. Capitol. Inside, the 19-foot marble statue of the 16th president is flanked by inscriptions of his second Inaugural Address and the famous Gettysburg Address. Next, we will go to Korean War Memorial and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. These two monuments honor members of the U.S. Armed Forces who fought in the wars. Take the D.C. Sightseeing Cruise (**optional**). Pass by Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Washington Monument, WWII Memorial and more.

Special Notes:

DC Sightseeing Cruise is usually to be closed from Jan to Mar. If U.S. Capitol closed to visitors, we will see the exterior of the building from outside. The Capitol Visitor Center is open to visitors from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday except for Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's and on Inauguration Day.

DAY 5: Washington – Corning – Niagara Falls (US side)

No meals

Arrive at one of Fortune Global 500's headquarters, Corning, to visit the Museum of Glass (**optional**). Its collection contains more than 45,000 objects. Guest will be invited to enjoy the Hot Glass Show which is performed by professional glass craftsmen. After your lunch, head for the renowned Niagara Falls. Overlooking American Fall, the Horseshoe Fall and the Bridal Veil Fall, you will be astounded by the deafening roar of the falls. Take the voyage on the famous "Maid of Mist" (**optional**) which gets passengers as close as possible to the Niagara Falls. Watch a Niagara IMAX movie (**optional**) which chronicles more than 12,000 years of history and examines human interaction with the falls. Later, you can join the Niagara Falls Night Tour (**optional**). Get closer to America's oldest state park at Niagara Falls State Park! Enjoy some awe-inspiring sceneries and adventure packed experience! Niagara Falls is not one waterfall but three. The Niagara River flows down from Lake Erie and is divided by Goat Island. Part of it flows to the horseshoe-shaped Canadian Falls (aptly named Horseshoe Falls) and the rest flows to the American Falls. At the American Falls, the river is also split by a second small island, Luna Island, creating the third small waterfalls known as Bridal Veil Falls.

Special notes:

1. Maid of the Mist usually opens during late April to early November.
2. The completeness of night view on certain summer evenings may be limited or not available due to late sunset time and US Federal Government regulations on driving time.

DAY 6: Niagara Falls (USA side) – Boston

No meals

Before crossing the upstate New York and leave for Boston where you will enjoy the magnificent view of the Erie Canal and mountains, we will do the Niagara In-depth Tour (**optional**). This interesting and exciting tour includes two popular attractions: the magnificent natural wonder – Niagara Whirlpool State Park and the U.S. historic landmark – Old Fort Niagara. (For those who don't want to join the in-depth tour, they can stay in the Falls Park for self-exploration). After the tour, you can take the Niagara Falls Jetboat Tour (**optional**). Experience the Niagara River like no other way possible. This exciting boat ride take passengers on a thrilling trip down the Niagara River! This round-trip ride zooms through the Niagara Gorge, and even takes passengers to the famous Whirlpool rapids, all in a custom-built jet boat. Drive to Boston afterwards and overnight.

DAY 7: Boston – Rhode Island – Boston

No meals

In the morning, the first stop of the day is Harvard University, a private Ivy League research university in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Then we will continue the tour with some exploration of Boston by taking the cruise to enjoy a breathtaking view of the Boston harbor. After that, we will see around the old Quincy Market, which is surrounded by dozens of restaurants for dining option with a variety of authentic cuisines, and absolutely, you cannot miss the famous New England clam chowder. And later, we will visit the smallest state in the US – Rhode Island, and visiting the Breakers mansion, one of the largest and grandest of the several historical Newport "cottages" that dot the ritzy coastline. The last stop of the day will be Plimoth Plantation, a living museum dedicated to telling the history of Plymouth Colony from the perspective of both the Pilgrims and the native Wampanoag people.

1. Plimoth Plantation will be closed to the public between January and March 2020
2. Pass by: Mayflower Ship, Plymouth Rock (Mayflower Ship will be back to State Pier in May 2020, and outside visit will be available then)
3. Boston City Sightseeing includes Old Trinity Cathedral, Hancock Building, Boston Athenaeum, Boston Park, Swan Lake Park, and overlook the Golden Dome of the State House.

DAY 8: Boston– New York City – Airport

No meals

The first stop will be the Harvard University at Cambridge, MA. Guests will be invited to visit its oldest campus district and take pictures with the Statue of Three Lies – Harvard Statue. Have a chance to walk around the campus of Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and take pictures with its main building. For the rest of the Boston tour, we will pass by old Trinity Cathedral, Hancock Building, Boston Athenaeum, Boston Park, Swan Lake Park, and overlook the Golden Dome of the State House. Board the cruise ship and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Boston Harbor. Next to old Quincy Market. Stroll through and get a taste of the historical ambience as well as pick up souvenirs. The market is surrounded by dozens of restaurants. Don't miss the famous New England clam chowder or try the famous lobsters feast. The trip will be completed at the Quincy Market around noon. Later guests will be sent to airports in Boston or in New York. Transfer to airport.
